Basic Information

- Rising K-5th graders
- June 18th thru August 3rd
- Monday - Friday
- 8:00am to 5:30pm

What to Wear Daily

- Comfortable & cool play clothes
- Sneakers with socks [no sandals, please!]

What to Bring Daily

[in case of unscheduled trips to pool or fountain]

- Bathing suit [ONE Piece or tankini for girls, trunks for boys]
- Towel
- Flip-flops/Crocs [only to be worn for pool or fountain]
- To avoid confusion and lost sunscreen, we provide waterproof sunscreen with a high SPF.
- Please mark ALL items clearly with child's name.

Lunch & Snack

- Campers must bring lunch each day. [unless otherwise specified]
- Please place in an insulated lunch bag.
- Please do not send soda/candy.
- We provide afternoon snack.

Field Trip Days

- Each camper **MUST WEAR** Camp T-shirt!
[T-shirts will be issued when camp begins.]
- We provide transportation by bus as needed.
- Campers will be broken into small groups with the chaperone/camper ratio at a maximum of 1:5.
- Parents will receive a Field Trip Info Flyer the day prior to the trip denoting departure time and specific details.

Safety

- CPR/AED & First Aid trained staff will be on campus each day.
- Due to the extreme Florida summer heat we work diligently to keep all campers hydrated and cool. Water will always be available!
- Special needs must be brought to the attention of the staff. We want all campers to have a happy and healthy experience.

Activities

- Free Play AM/PM [start of day/end of day]
- Morning & Afternoon Devotions
- Lakeside Playground - weekly AM trip
- Full Camp - whole camp themed activities
- Rotations - small group themed activities
- Lakeside Pool - every T/Th for 2 hours
 - Campers will have the opportunity to be swim-tested. If they pass the test, they will wear a yellow wristband to designate that they can swim in the deep end of the pool. All those without a wristband must remain in the shallow end.

- Special Event - Friday end-of-week celebration
