

KENYA FEED 500
FOOD IS LOVE IN ACTION

One in ten children in Kenya has lost either one or both parents due to AIDS. Orphaned children are absorbed into extended family or with neighbors who are already in dire straits themselves. The average Kenyan child eats once every 2-3 days. Food is scarce in Kenya and many children die of malnutrition.

At Utange Orphans Mission, The FEED500 program feeds the body and the soul of community children. Every Saturday morning, the children sing, are taught Bible lessons and fed a hot meal. They are each given a bag of fortified maize flour to take home which will sustain them for a week. In doing so, the children arrive each week with anticipation and excitement of HOPE for a brighter future.

At Utange Orphans in Kenya , \$5.00 in U.S. currency will feed a child for one week.
